You will study a range of subject modules in small, interactive, and supportive classes with a focus on your personal development to help you achieve, succeed, and grow.



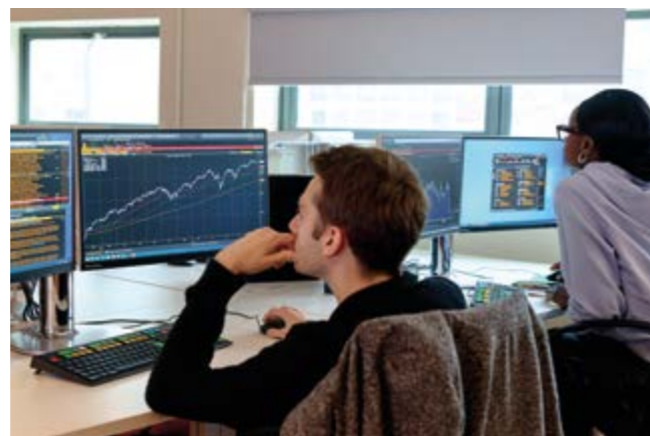

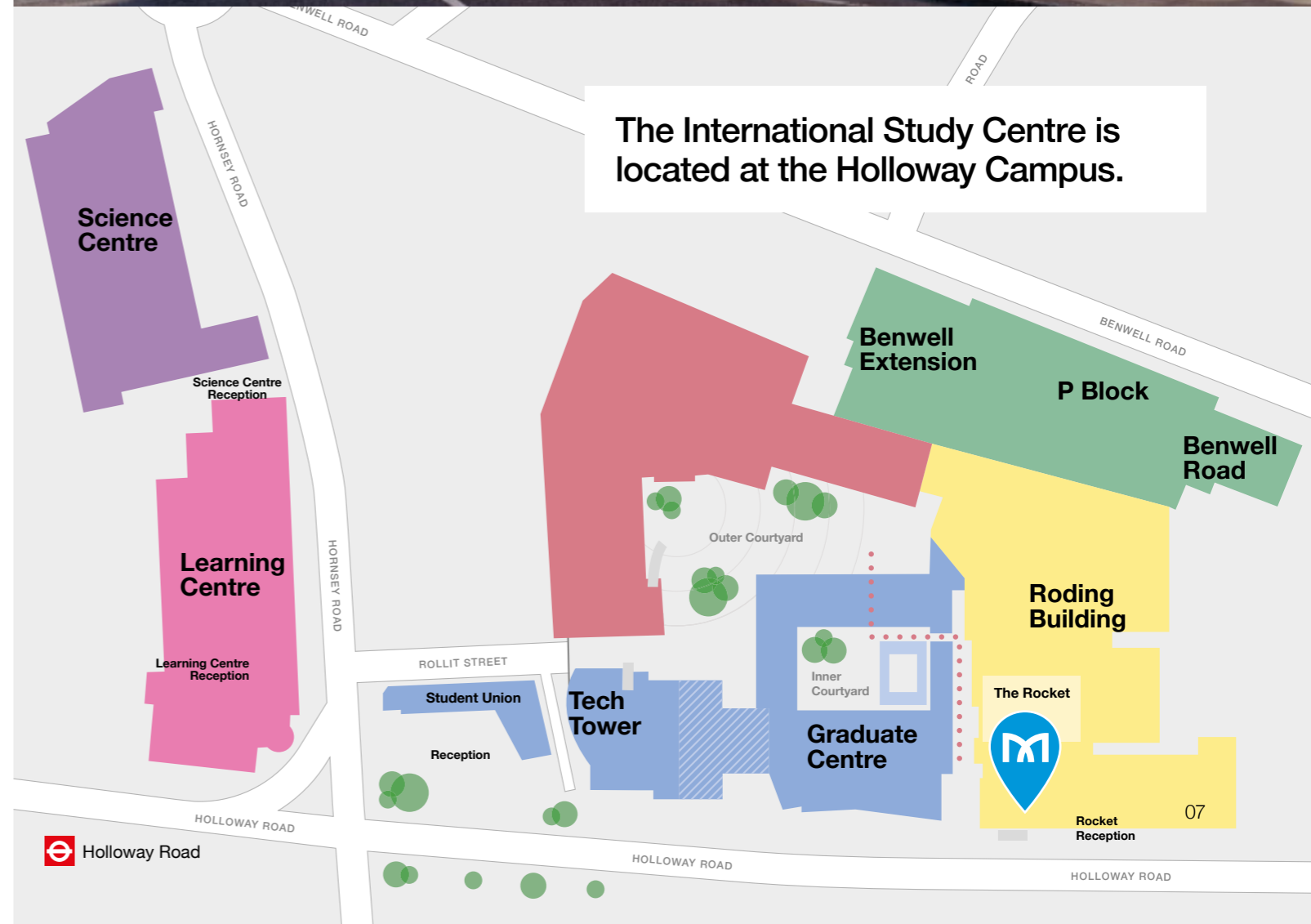
Dedicated support team

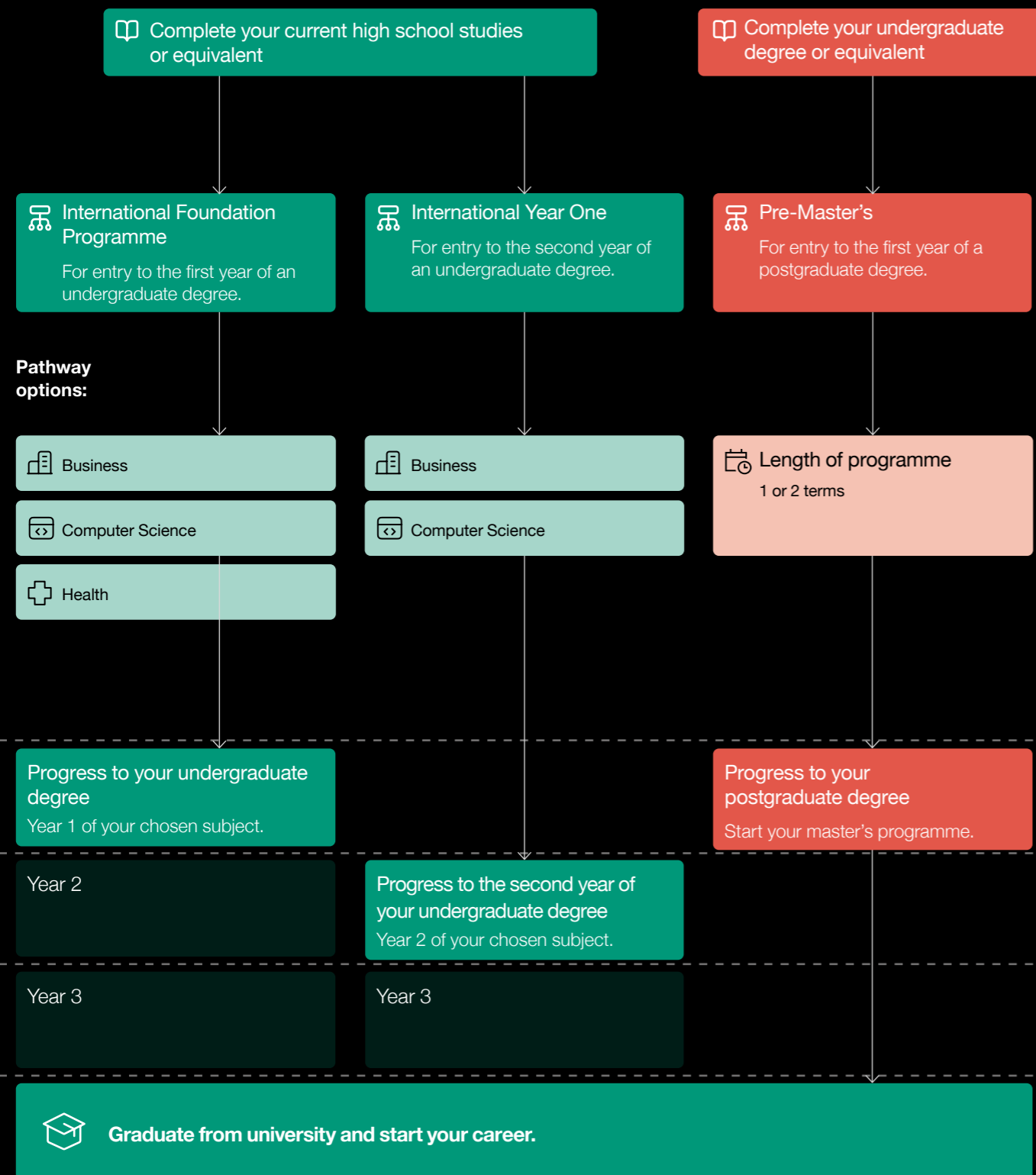

Your route to London Metropolitan University

You can qualify for entry to an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at London Metropolitan University, depending on which pathway programme is right for you.

International Foundation Programme

4-year degree programme

This integrated programme is designed to give you a seamless transition from foundation to your degree programme.

It will prepare you for studying at undergraduate level. You will gradually develop the skills needed for university study through interactive and supportive classroom teaching.

You will study three core modules, including English for Academic Purposes and tailor your learning by taking related streams for your chosen progression degree.

Entry criteria

Minimum English language level: Academic IELTS 5.5 overall (with no component below 5.5) or equivalent.

Academic entry requirements: 5 GCSEs at grade 4/C or above (or equivalent). For country-specific entry requirements please scan the QR code:



Minimum age requirement: **September start:** Students may be 16 at the start of the programme but must turn 17 by 31 December of the year in which the programme begins.

January and May start: Students must be 17 years of age at the commencement of the programme.

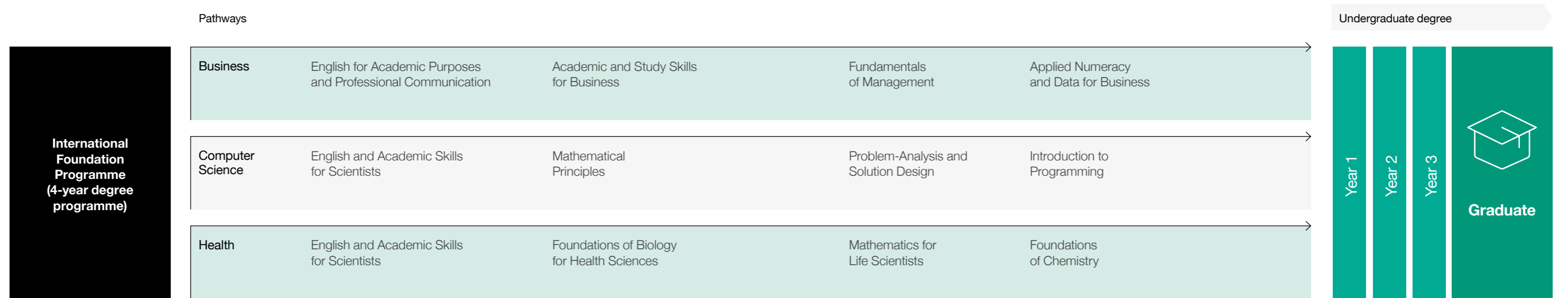

Progression route



International Year One

This programme is equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree.

As part of the International Year One, you will study in university-style classes, learning through a combination of classroom teaching, small group tuition, personal tutorial sessions and lecture-style classes. You will then progress to Year 2 of your undergraduate degree.

This programme is designed to significantly improve your academic language skills, including critical thinking and academic writing, whilst allowing you the additional classroom support you need from our qualified teachers.


You will study one core module, English for Academic Purposes and specialist modules that are specific to the stream you select.

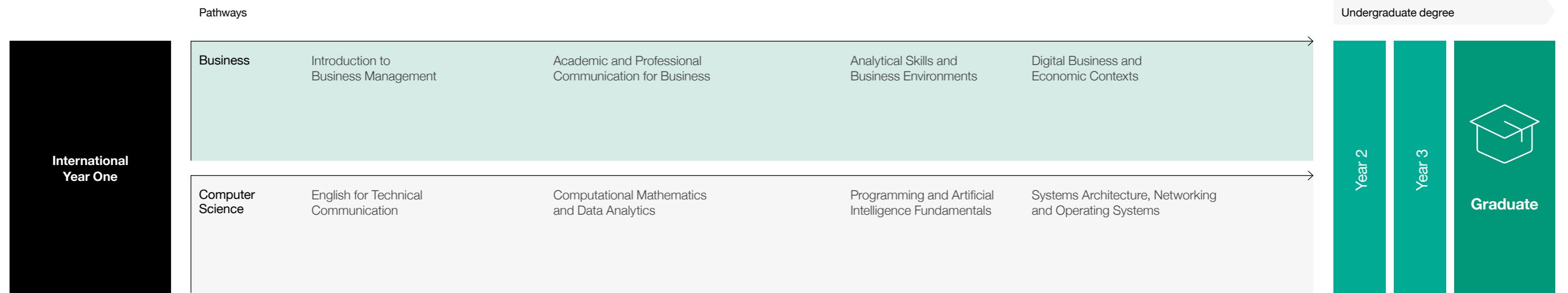

Pre-Master's Programme


This programme is designed to prepare you for your studies by allowing you to practice your academic skills in a supportive environment.


Though you may have experience of studying at undergraduate level in another country, the expectations of postgraduate study can be very different in the UK.

Through interactive classes and university-style research sessions, by the time you finish this programme, you will have the fundamental skills you need to attain your master's degree.

Entry criteria

Length of programme	1 or 2 terms
Minimum English language level:	Academic IELTS 5.5 overall (and no component below 5.5) or equivalent.
Academic entry requirements:	A pass in an undergraduate degree or a Diploma (3–5 years) with suitable grades or equivalent. Successful completion of higher/advanced diploma in a related subject area. For country-specific entry requirements please scan the QR code: 
Minimum age requirement:	All students must be a minimum of 17 years of age prior to the start of the course.

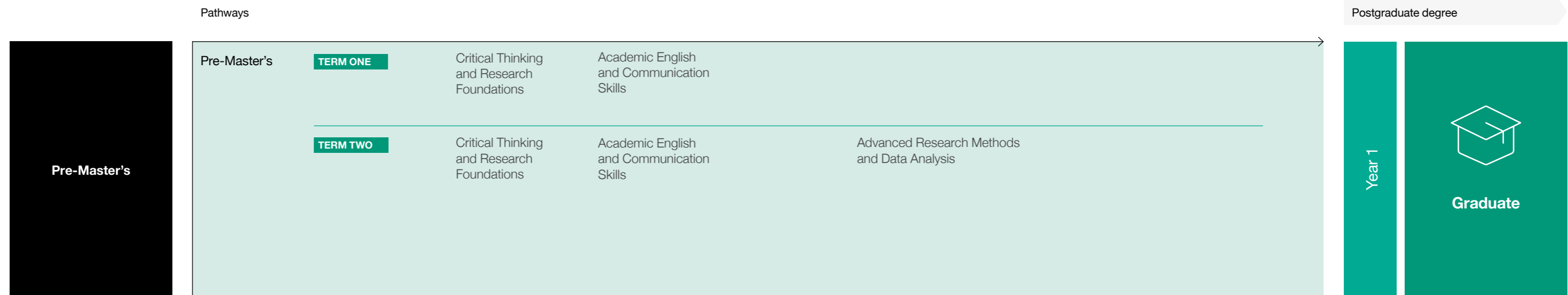

“Growing up in Ghana, I had friends who passed away from malaria, so I developed a passion to conduct more research into malaria and help develop more effective medication against different strains of malaria. My MSc project at London Met which was carried out in the very well-equipped Science Centre was focused on developing a new and more effective anti-malarial drug range called GDH-inhibitor antimalarials. With help from my supervisory team at London Met, I was successful in synthesising a very pure form of this potential anti-malarial medication. These will eventually need to undergo clinical trials before being used as anti-malarials.”

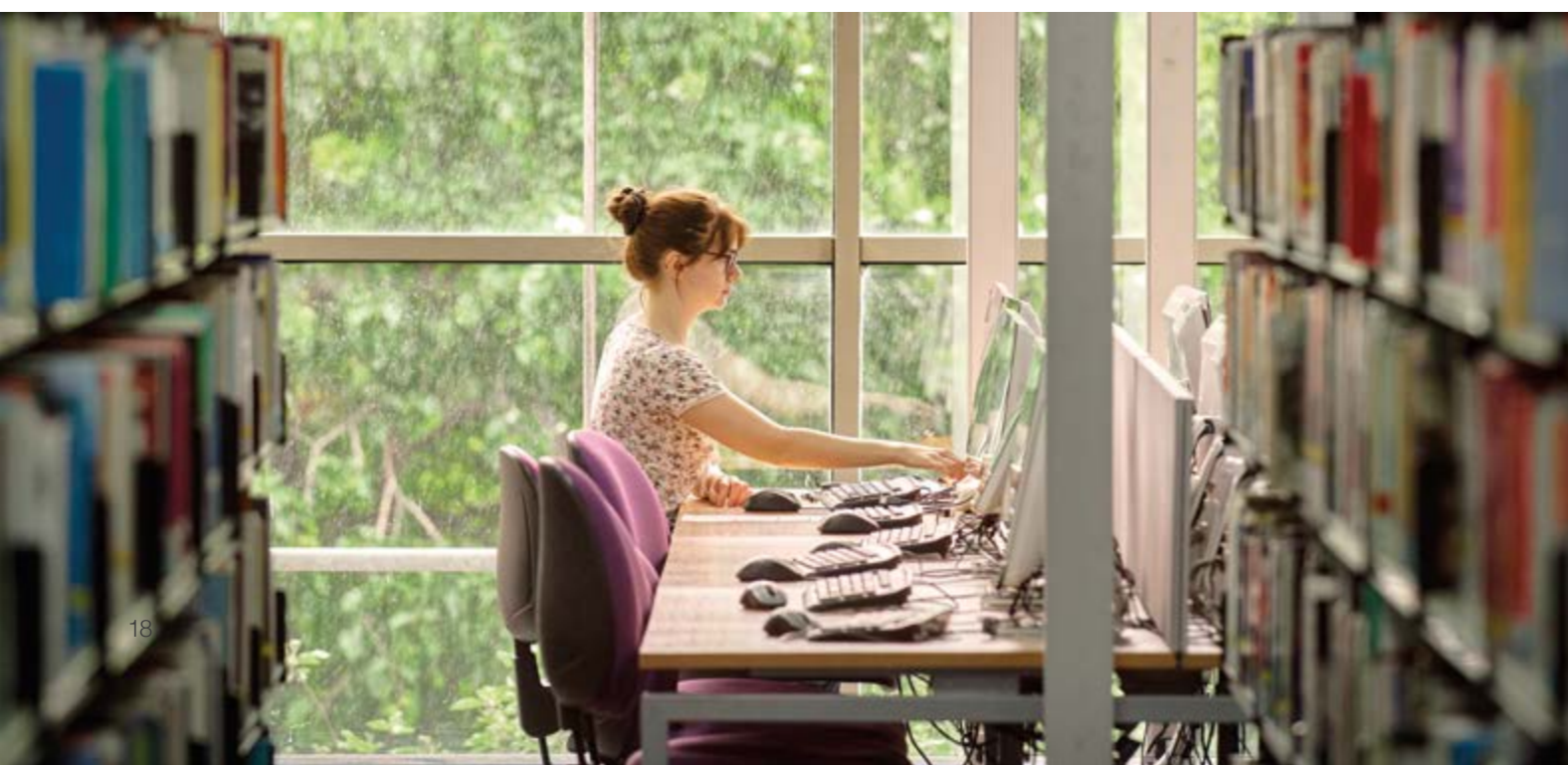






Halls of residence

London Metropolitan University works with a number of purpose-built student halls located across London, offering convenient access to campuses, excellent transport links, and a lively student community.

Halls of residence are ideal for students who want to live independently while enjoying the social benefits of student life.

Typical features include:

-  Private single study bedrooms
-  Options for en-suite or shared bathroom facilities
-  Shared kitchen and dining areas
-  Furnished rooms with bed, study space, storage, and seating
-  Free Wi-Fi and utilities included
-  On-site security and support services
-  Social spaces for studying, relaxing, and meeting other students

Please note: Availability, room types, contract lengths, and costs vary depending on the residence.

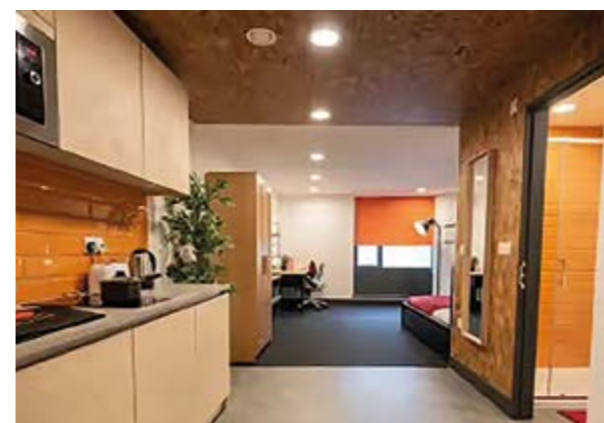


Optivo - Goldsmiths House








Homestay accommodation

Homestay is a popular option for students who would like a more personal living experience and the opportunity to immerse themselves in UK culture.

Students live with a carefully selected host in London, offering a welcoming home environment and additional support for those studying in the UK for the first time.

Homestay benefits include:

-  A private bedroom in a family home
-  A safe, supportive, and friendly environment
-  Options with meals included
-  An opportunity to practise English in everyday situations
-  Hosts located within commuting distance of the university





Homestay accommodation provides comfort, cultural exchange, and peace of mind while studying in London.

Private accommodation

Private accommodation offers students the chance to live independently in flats, houses, or rooms rented from private landlords. It provides flexibility and the opportunity to choose who you live with, while often being more affordable than halls of residence.

Students can live alone, share a flat with friends, or rent a room in a shared house. The university provides access to services like Student Pad to help find properties and connect with potential housemates.

Benefits of private accommodation include:

-  A variety of housing options across London
-  Flexible tenancy agreements
-  Opportunities to live with friends or choose housemates
-  Potentially lower rent than student halls

Students should be prepared to manage utility bills and understand their rights and responsibilities as tenants.

Private accommodation provides independence, choice, and a chance to experience London life outside of university-managed housing.

Next steps

1. Application:

Submit your application online: isc.londonmet.ac.uk/apply or scan the QR code below



Our team will contact you to submit your supporting documents:

- A copy of your passport
- A copy of your academic transcript and certificate
- Proof of your English language level (UKVI IELTS or equivalent)
- A Personal Statement

Additional documentation may be required depending on your application. If our team need more information, we will let you know.

2. Admissions assessment:

Our Admissions team will review your application and documents. Some students may be called for pre-screening so keep an eye out for a call from us.

3. Offer letter:

We will send you an offer letter. It may be conditional, and we'll let you know what we will need from you, or it will be unconditional. If we think the course is not right for you, we will suggest an alternative.

4. Accept your offer:

To hold your place on the course, you will need to meet all the remaining conditions. We can only confirm your place once all conditions have been met and the deposit paid. Please note that if you require a visa to study with us, you may need to provide additional evidence to comply with the visa regulations in the UK. You may also need to pass a credibility interview. We'll let you know more about how to prepare.

5. CAS issued:

Once you have paid your remaining fees, met all the conditions of offer, and passed a credibility interview if required, we will confirm your place and send you a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). You will need this to obtain a visa. Please note a CAS can only be issued up to six months before the start of the course (if you apply from outside the UK) or up to three months (if you are eligible to apply from within the UK).

6. Apply for visa:

You will then need to apply for your visa. It is your responsibility to obtain a visa before you travel to join the course. If you do not have a valid visa for studies in the UK, you will not be able to join the course.

7. Arrival:

You should arrive on the weekend before the start date of the course. Please tell us when you are coming. We will send you pre-arrival information about your course and life in the UK.
